BRITISH SHOW PONY SOCIETY

This show is affiliated to The British Show Pony Society (BSPS No 18/10) and all persons entering competing showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not a member of the BSPS, are subject to the constitution and rules of the BSPS including disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS PLEASE NOTE RIHS and BLUE RIBAND classes, Owners and Riders must be BSPS members to compete in these classes.

2010 ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW

Ponies must be registered with the BSPS and ponies must be registered with the AHS for the RIHS Anglo & Part bred Arab classes. The following classes are qualifiers for the RIHS:- 2-6, 8-10 (NPS Rules), 11-12, 14-16. 17-18, 19-23, 29-31 (P(UK) Rules, 36-37, 39-43, 44-46 51-56(BMHS Rules). Only ONE horse/pony may qualify from each class. The highest placed (not already qualified) from the first 5 horses/ponies placed in each class will qualify. Class 7, 32-35 are qualifiers for the BSPS Premier League.

THE CHERIF CHAMPIONSHIP - Classes 17-18 are qualifiers for the Cherif Championships 2010

PONIES ASSOCIATION (UK) Qualification for the Summer National Championships 1st 2nd and 3rd placed horses/ponies in all Summer National Championships will qualify for the 2010 P(UK) Summer National Championships.

Results must be submitted to the Ponies (UK) offices within 14 days of the qualifying show with the exception of shows being held between 5 July and 26 July need to submit their results within 48 hours after the qualifying event. Qualification cards will not be presented in the ring.

Competitors in qualifying positions who are **NOT** current members of P(UK) are allowed **14 days** in which to become members and register their horses/ponies in order for the qualification to remain valid. The exception being any competitor qualifying at a show between 5 July and 26 July must submit their membership within 48 hours after the qualifying event in order for the qualification to remain valid.

NPS MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND QUALIFYING ROUNDS: These classes are judged under the rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Books. Part Breds are not eligible.

Qualifying Rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non members but only ponies owned by adult NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition.

The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the final.

Where this pony has already qualifies, the pony standing next in line, owed by an NPS member, and has not already qualified receives the qualification.

Qualification may go no lower than 3rd place. NPS Adult/Standard Members will be required to upgrade to adult/showing to enter the final.

HEALTH & SAFETY

1. Correctly secured British Skull/Riding Hats Nos EN1384 PAS 015 or ASTM F 1163 that

meet current safety standards **MUST BE WORN** at all times when mounted.

2. Health & Safety. This show is run with due regard to Health & Safety. The Health and Safety Officer on the day will be Mrs Ann Brickell. We request that all exhibitors and members of the public comply with any request, verbal or written from Show Officials, which pertain to Health and Safety matters. Details guidelines can be seen in the Secretary's office.
3. Any accident must be reported to the show official as soon as possible. First Aiders will be on duty for all classes.
4. All Ridden Horses and Ponies must be 4 years old or over.
5. Only tack that is permissible in the Show Ring is allowed on the Show Ground. No spurs may be worn in any of the affiliated classes and no gadgets whatsoever can be used for exercising ponies prior to competing.
6. No claims can be entertained for anything that may happen to competitors, onlookers, servants, animals or property in connection with or arising from this show.
7. DOGS must be kept on leads at all times.
8. All lunging of horses or ponies to be carried out in the Horsebox Park ONLY.
9. THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL
10. The judges named in the schedule have accepted our invitation to judge. The committee reserve the right to appoint a substitute for any Judge who in unable to attend.
11. The Committee reserve the right to refuse entries.
12. No nomination or substitute entries are allowed.
13. Entries received after the closing date will be subject to Late Entry Fees.
14. No entry fees will be refunded for any reason other than Cancellation of the Show.
15. In the event of the show being cancelled £5.00 will be retained for each entry towards the cost of administration
