Individual sections of unaffiliated classes 4, 5 and 6- £15 each

£5.00 per competitor for First Aid cover.

This show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the constitution and rules of the BSPS including the disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS. Owners and riders must be BSPS members before the date of the show to compete in The White Company qualifying classes.

CLASSES 1, 2, 3 MAXIMUM HEIGHT FOR FENCES

OPEN CLASSES – OPEN HEIGHT

Entry fee for classes 1 to 3 - £45

1st - £40 (4 or more entries) 2nd - £20 (7 or more entries) 3rd - £15 (10 or more entries)

CLASS 1 THE OPEN 133cms GOLD CUP

(Section A) DRESSAGE (Section B) COMBINED WSP

(Section C) SHOW JUMPING

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cms.

Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year

CLASS 2 THE OPEN 143cms GOLD CUP

(Section A) DRESSAGE (Section B) COMBINED WSP

(Section C) SHOW JUMPING

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 133cms and not exceeding 143cms

Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year

CLASS 3 THE OPEN 153cms GOLD CUP

(Section A) DRESSAGE (Section B) COMBINED WSP

(Section C) SHOW JUMPING

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 143cms and not exceeding 153cms

Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year

Classes 4, 5 and 6 are not affiliated to the BSPS and open to any rider and any pony or horse whether or not they are a member. These unaffiliated classes can also be entered by section, so not all three phases have to be entered.

Entry fee for each section 4a, 4b and 4c and 5a, 5b and 5c and 6a, 6b and 6c - £15

Prize money will only be given to the award winners in the combined Gold cup competition.

1st - £40 (4 or more entries) 2nd - £20 (7 or more entries) 3rd - £15 (10 or more entries)

CLASS 4 THE OPEN GOLD CUP

(Section A) DRESSAGE (Section B) Working Sports Horse

(Section C) SHOW JUMPING

Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 153cms. Jumps in WSP and SJ not to exceed 1m 10cm

This class is not a qualifier for the Burghley Gold Cup Competition

CLASS 5 THE MINI/NOVICE GOLD CUP

(Section A) DRESSAGE (Section B) WSP
(Section C) SHOW JUMPING
Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, plaited or heritage. Jumps in WSP and SJ not to exceed 60cm
This class is not a qualifier for the Burghley Gold Cup Competition

CLASS 6 THE NURSERY/NOVICE GOLD CUP

(Section A) DRESSAGE (Section B) WSP
(Section C) SHOW JUMPING
Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, plaited or heritage. Jumps in WSP and SJ not to exceed 75cm
This class is not a qualifier for the Burghley Gold Cup Competition

METHOD OF JUDGING
THE BSPS GOLD CUP SPORTS PONY

To be run in accordance with the BSPS Rules for Combined & Gold Cup.

Competitors must compete in Sections A, B and C.

Marks attained in Section A – Dressage and Section B- WSP, shall be added together.

Any penalties incurred in Section C – Jumping will be deducted from the total of Section A and B.

The winner of the combined class will then be the one with the highest remaining score.

In the event of a tie or ties, the highest dressage score will determine the winner, if there is still equality the highest WSP style mark followed by the fastest show jumping time will determine the winner.

SECTION A – DRESSAGE

Pony Club 100 Eventing Test 2015

Copies are downloadable from The Pony Club website and for sale for Areas that are running events.

After completing the Dressage competitors will be allowed a short time in the collecting ring to change bridles and warm up for the WSP section.

SECTION B – WORKING SPORTS PONY

ANY SUITABLE BRIDLE. MARTINGALES ARE PERMITTED

Maximum Height of Fences – OPEN HEIGHT

The Course will consist of a mixture of Rustic WHP and Cross-Country style fences, water may be included.

Ponies will be awarded a Mark out of 10 for their gallop.

The Marks for the gallop may be displayed.

MARKING

Jumping	60 MARKS
Style and Manners while jumping	20 MARKS
Gallop	10 MARKS
Position of Seat and Effectiveness of Rider	10 MARKS
TOTAL	<u>100 MARKS</u>

PENALTIES

Knock down penalties	10 penalties
First Refusal	15 penalties
Second Refusal	20 penalties
Third Refusal	Elimination
Fall of Pony or Rider	Elimination

An elimination in this section will result in 150 points being deducted from the total score.

WSP – scores lower than 20 regardless of combined placing will not go forward to show jumping.

SECTION C – SHOW JUMPING

ANY SUITABLE BRIDLE. MARTINGALES ARE PERMITTED

The Jumping section will be judged on one round, over coloured and/ or rustic fences. There will be an optimum time for the course and penalties will be incurred for exceeding this time.

There will be an alternative Fence and a BONUS MARK OF 10 will be awarded to competitors who successfully jump the alternative fence.

The competitor with the lowest score will jump first.

PENALTIES

Knock Down	10 penalties
First Refusal	15 penalties
Second Refusal	20 penalties
Knock Down Alternative Fence	20 penalties
Third Refusal	Elimination
Fall of Pony or rider	Elimination

SECTION C will be a jumping course. Joker fence to be added for Open

Any penalties incurred in Section C will be deducted from the total points of Sections A and B.

In the event of elimination in Section C 100 penalty points will be deducted from the competitors score carried forward from Sections A, B and C.

Anyone eliminated in S/J will not come forward for overall rosette.

No rider will be allowed to ride more than one pony per section

THE HIGHEST PLACED PONY IN THE OPEN 133CM, 143CM AND 153CM NOT ALREADY QUALIFIED, OWNED REGISTERED AND RIDDEN BY BSPS MEMBERS IN CLASSES WILL QUALIFY FOR

Rules and Conditions of Entry

1. The committee reserve the right to alter the times or order of classes.
2. The committee does not accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property at the show.
3. Mounted exhibitors must adhere to horse walkways and riding area.
4. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
5. All entries must be paid in full when entering. NO ENTRY FEE WILL BE REFUNDED unless supported by a vet or doctor's certificate. In this case £5 admin fee will be charged.
6. The committee reserve the right to refuse any entry. Anyone displaying aggressive or threatening behaviour will be ejected from the showground without any refund of entry fees, and reported to BSPS.
7. The Judge's decision is final.
8. All marks will be double checked at the secretary's office and if found to be incorrect places will be adjusted to allow for this. Mark sheets will be displayed on the day then available on BSPS AREA 14 facebook page following the show.
9. This show is run with due regard to Health & Safety. Everyone in attendance must abide by the instructions given by officials. All vehicles must be parked where instructed by the car park stewards.

10. Correctly secure Skull Caps/Riding Hats Nos A11 PAS015,VGL, ASTM F1163 04a onwards. SNELL E2001,AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards. MUST be worn by riders at all times whilst mounted.
11. Riders in BSPS WSP and show jumping classes are required to wear a body protector, rule 49a.
12. All prize money is to be collected from the Secretary's Office on the day of the show. Failure to collect on the day will forfeit any prize money.
13. No clearing out of horse boxes is allowed on the showground anyone found will be fined. Please ensure you take ALL litter HOME WITH YOU.
